

## "THE AMERICAS AND EUROPE'S ARMAGEDDON"

The next club dinner will be addressed by the number one foreign correspondent of North America.

In keeping with club policy of inviting the world's leading authorities to address it, the club officers have arranged for Leland Stowe to discuss present world affairs from the view-point of the nations of North and South America. He is peculiarly fitted for this discussion since he attended and reported several Pan-American conferences and has seen all parts of Europe since the outbreak of World War II.

In his address to the club, Mr. Stowe will give his views on the aftermath of the present conflict as it affects the nations of the Western Hemisphere—their finances, their imports, exports, domestic economy, national production, population trends, and forms of government. He will give his opinion on the spread or decline of fascism and communism and state capitalism and democracy.

America's number one foreign correspondent. Returned to America from France January, 1945. Gave weekly broadcast from France during fall of 1944.

Pulitzer Prize winner for the best foreign correspondence 1930.

For twenty years has covered almost every important political or diplomatic event and war front.

Russia (including Stalingrad—the only foreign correspondent permitted at the front), China, India, the East Indies, Finland, North Africa, Italy, France—all these and others have been visited and reported by him since the outbreak of World War II.

Reported the uprisings in Spain, overthrow of ten governments in France, Italian intrigues in Albania and Africa, Reichstag Fire Trial, Pan-American Conferences in South America, etc.

Has addressed most of North America's outstanding audiences.

Probably has a clearer and more personal view of recent world developments than any other citizen of North America.
