General Manager of the bank Kansallis-Osake-Pankki. Prime Minister 1918. Leader of Conservative party 1934-36. Finnish Minister in Stockholm 1936-1940, in Moscow 1940-41. Chairman of Finnish Delegation at Peace Conference in Tartu 1920 and of Finnish Delegation at International Economic Conference in Geneva 1927. Finnish Delegate for political negotiations in Moscow autumn 1939, and Member of Peace Delegation in Moscow March 1940; Delegate for negotiations in Moscow March 1944. Minister without portfolio 1939-40. Prime Minister November 1944 to March 1946. President of the Republic since March 1946. Re-elected for the period 1.3.1950 - 1.3.1956.
