Hanna Rydh, Dr phil. at the university of Uppsala 1919, archeologist, main subject northern and comparative prehistory.

Has taken an active part as young in the studentmovement, later in the women's movement and social and political life (member of the Swedish parliament 1942 - 43).

Married 1919 to the professor of Archeology Bror Schnittger, who died 1924 and with whomashe has to sons, Jan, dr. of technology, (married and has a little daughter) and Bror (studyings at the commercial university in Stockholm, also married).

Dr Rydh married the second time in 1929 the governor M. Munck af Rosenschöld, who died 1942, and with whome she has the daughter Karin, studying law. During her husbands governmentship she had a very active social life and was the president of many different activities in the province of Jämtland.
