

Dear Sir or Basave

I am ashamed of not having answered your obliging letter of 2.8.23. Somehow I rather got out of the habit of writing much while at Insuada, partly from being out of doors a good deal in an ideal climate, partly from worry about our unfortunate Friend. I had expected I have found something definite on my return here (this morning) But there is not a line. The whole thing is a most unpleasant mystery. Had Dr Pillay reached home safely it is quite impossible that he should not have written to me. On the other hand the English & the not admirable individuals they are fools enough to let themselves be fleeced & degraded by me at present in a most objectionable state of mind. I have the sorrow certainly that they had a young friend & pupil of mine at Leoti Levante, murdered in the most brutal & disgusting way to discharge their virulent fanaticism against what & whom who knows. And their General election during which they go even madder than they are normally & now on & till its over its useless to try & get inquiries made. I had a letter from the artist Henry Bernard from Guadalajara whom you have I think made the acquaintance of dated Hotel Casa Blanca 22 Oct^o. Apparently he finds Guadalajara so attractive that he is loath to leave it. I quite expected to have forced him here, as apparently there have been several boats from Manzanillo to Acapulco

have come by. However, it was much the same whether he stayed with us or here. All the same after the considerable rains of the last ten days, La Paz is looking really beautiful and is not now at all too hot, so there will be much for him to do and when he turns up he may be sure of a hospitable reception.

I think when & if you get through sacrifice you will find the general idea & the plot & working out of it not amiss. It may, however, appeal more to the Anglo Saxon blood & thunder loving mentality than the Latin. I believe the 1^o (final) edition is sold out and a 2^o paper one is or has been printed.
