Dear Señor Basave,

It is most kind of you to send me a copy of your "Cuadros Cronologicos" with the interesting tables of Arts, Literature, and Philosophy of the World and the cordial inscription you have written in the work. I am very glad to possess this tabulated record of cultural events and peoples, and I congratulate you sincerely upon a notable performance. How you managed to digest so much material in Mexico and away from Great National Libraries surprises me. You must have a most comprehensive historical collection yourself as well as very wide interests to have been able to put the lines of development together so clearly as you have done.

I expect that you know the work by Dr. S.H. Steinberg, published by Macmillan and Co., entitled "Historical Tables 55 B.C.-A.D. 1945." I have another collection of such tables entitled "Tables of European History, Literature, Science and Art, from A.D. 200-1909, and of American History, Literature and Art" by Dr. John Nicol. This was published in 1909 by Messrs James MacLehose and Sons, Glasgow, but I am not sure if it is still obtainable or if it has been brought up-to-date since 1909.

I am enclosing a copy of the organ of the Ethical Union, of which I am the President, containing an article in which I think you may be interested. This article is really the substance of a chapter in a work of about one hundred thousand words entitled "Gods and Men" which
