BRITAIN'S NEW PRIME MINISTER IS MACMILLAN.

Mr. Macmillan waves to the large crowd in Downing Street on his return from Buckingham Palace after accepting from Her Majesty the Queen his appointment as Prime Minister of Britain.

He is 62 and had been Chancellor of the Exchequer since December, 1955.

In a telerecording to the nation Mr. Macmillan said: "This afternoon the Queen did me the great honour to ask me to form a Government. I have accepted this duty. The occasion is a sad one for me, brought about as it is by the retirement (through ill-health) of my old and very dear friend Anthony Eden."
