The project developed 10 online seminars regarding the use, development and identification of open educational resources and inclusive education. The recording of these seminars remains as open access on the official website of the project as an open educational resource for Spanish-speaking and Anglo-Saxon audiences (https://www.wununesco.world/); this through YouTube (https://bit.ly/3ICu52C) and the institutional repository of Tecnologico de Monterrey (https://bit.ly/3pqCyyj).

We delivered ten wonderful webinars, thank you very much for this great contribution to open education. With a training reach of 953 registrants, 526 answered the first survey, and 253 certificates were awarded to those who covered at least 8 webinars and answered the initial and final instrument. Certificates have already been sent to those who passed.

The project evolved adequately and was scaled through the "Community STEAM-OER-LATAM" project (https://www.oer-steam.world/), which seeks to cooperate and facilitate the transition of the RED STEAM Latam towards the STEAM-OER-LATAM Community.
