
Dear Sir,

concerning your letter of May 7th, 1947 addressed to Cardinal Joseph Mindszenty, Archbishop of Esztergom, Prince Primate of Hungary I have the honour to inform you, that His Eminence has forwarded this letter - like all the other matters of press - to me, the chief editor of the Hungarian Courier (Magyar Kurir), the South-East European official information service, who am at the same time also the Budapest correspondent of the semi-official organ of the Vatican and of the Radio Vatican as well as of the National Catholic Welfare Conference News Service (Washington). In my abovementioned capacity I take the liberty to send you the requested photograph and the biographical data. I hope they will satisfy you. May I at the same time offer my services, I would with the greatest pleasure send reports to you newspaper. His Eminency has specially advised me to do so, believing, that the events of Hungarian catholic life would certainly interest the Catholics in Mexico, 70 p.c. of the Hungarian population being catholic. I am in connection by way of cable (credited) and of airmail with the semi-official of the Vatican and with the American Catholic News Service. I send airmail once every week, while I cable only in very important or urgent case.
