

Curriculum Vital

I was born in 1878 in Patras, Greece.
after my studies in Athens, at the age of sixteen
I went to Italy, and attended classes at the Academy
of Naples, under the masters Domenico Morelli and
Philippo Polizzi. After three years of studies and
after carrying off the highest prizes, I left for Rome
and Venice where I stayed for four years. In
1900 my first work the "Odalisques" was published
in the official bulletin of the International Expo-
sition of Paris and was awarded a prize.
Afterwards I occupied myself exclusively with the
Greek landscape and outdoor scenery.
In 1915 I participated in a contest for the position
of Professorship at the High School of Fine Arts, where
I have taught for 33 consecutive years as Professor
and Director. In 1927 I was honoured by the
"Academy of Athens" with the National medal
of arts. In 1930 I became an "associate-member of
the Academy, and in 1945 became its regular member.
My works are very numerous. It is hardly possible
for me to determine the exact number of them.

It is sufficient to say that I participated in 67 ex-
positions private, local and foreign.
Moreover, it is worth mentioning, I have been ho-
nored by Greek and Italian Governments with
their respective "Taxiarchis" comenda medals.
