I thank you for your kind letter of July 26th and I shall try to answer your questions as good as possible.

I was born on July 21 1898 as a son of the Bishop Bruun-Rasmussen and in 1931 I married and have now three children. I became a student in 1917 and graduated from the faculty of law in 1924. Since then I have been a referee and a literary adviser at different publishing house, and since 1929 at Nyt Nordisk Forlag in Copenhagen. I am a member of the presidium of different literary organisations and editor of different periodicals, partly literary, partly connected to the police force. I am a teacher in psychology and pedagogics at the Royal School for education of the police, and a leader at the school for watchmen.

Have written: Digte (poetry) 1920, Smaa Lygter (small lanterns) 1920, Den rolige Glæde (the quiet pleasure) 1921, Kentaur 1926, Novemberstorm (storm in November) 1927, Hakon Jørgensen 1927, En Herre viser sig (a gentleman shows up) 1929, Dagsrejse (a day's journey) 1929, Det ligger i luften (it's in the air) 1930, Gaden og Mennesket (the street and the man) 1930, Dette ene Liv (this only life) 1932, Morgendrømme (dreams in the morning) 1933, Ansigtet i Spejlet (the face in the mirror) 1947. Furthermore I have participated in the edition of the memorial edition of Kaj Munk's works. I have translated books by John Dos Passos, Louis Golding, Thomas Wolfe, Schalom Asch, Jaroslav Hasek, Ernst Wiechert and Ivan Olbracht.

In my work as a literary adviser to the publishing house I am emphasising the development of the young Danish literature.
