Dear Signor Basave

I am writing a line to inform you that
about a fortnight ago I received a letter
from my Tamil friend's father in Law from
Dr. Sankararaman Pillay Court Physician
& the Maharajah of Travancore definitely
confirming my fear that Dr. Pillay had
been murdered by the detestable English
people & their Imperialist ministers
for Foreign Affairs, the infamous
G. N. Curzon. The two secret agents of the
English Foreign ^{Office} (apparently with the full
connivance of the Captain of the Andra
de Poon (Munagers' manitines) dragged
Dr. Pillay off the steamer at Penang
& either murdered him then & there or
he has been tortured to death in one of the
numerous prison & hospital cells the
English maintain for the purpose in the
East. It was during the viceroyship of
this Imperialist & criminal maniac

that the numérationable woman fortune
was either devised or at any rate reached
its highest development. I am having
D. Sankaramurti's letter printed & will
send you a copy. It renders the fate of
Dr. Pillay, we may say, an absolute
certainty. Collateral evidence also leaves
as little doubt that the crime was committed
by order of Lord Curzon to satisfy his
touchy vanity & stupid malignity
towards myself. The matter will
not be allowed to drop. What little that
can be done to bring the crime home to the
real criminal will be. It may not be
known in Mexico, that not very long ago
at least so I was informed on most reliable
authority, the English Consuls were
transferred from the Board of Trade
& are now under the thumb of the
English Foreign office & the numerous
secret service or under agents of this

corrupt department of the English State
are under their control. As according
to a somewhat unfortunate regulation
English subjects entering Mexico have
to have their passports viséd by a British
consul & by an equally unlucky fatality
Dr. Pillay instead of having his viséd in
Paris, waited till he got to New York
this facilitated the arrangement for his
murder by the English Consuls at New
York and San Francisco respectively.
This last but not perhaps worst of the
dastardly crimes of the English Imperialist
Government points the moral & kept
insisting upon with perhaps too much
iteration, to Foreign countries strong or
weak - the warning of Herbert Spencer
of Japan in the first years of its new life -
"Keep the English out of your country at all
costs and if they are there no price is too
heavy to pay down to the halving or quartering
of the population in the effort, by tried
of them not and branch."
