Dear Mr du Solier,

Your letter of about the Isla de Sacrificios paper has been forwarded to me here, and was awaiting me on my return to Guatemala City.

I have spoken to Dr Kidder about it, and he has consented to its publication in our "Notes on Middle American Archaeology and Ethnology" Series in English and without colored plates. If you are agreeable, I will translate it into English when I return to the States, and send you a copy for your approval before it is printed. As you know, we try to keep the Notes Series as short as possible, and in translating into English, I shall conform to the system we have adopted of suppressing all unnecessary words and phrases, so that the paper emerges in a style which is rather that of a business document, than a paper in a truly literary style. The illustrations can be grouped so that they will occupy only three or four plates.

If this plan meets with your approval, will you let me know, and then when I return to the United States in May, I can go ahead with the preparation of the manuscript.

I would very much appreciate it if you would let me know of any definite arrangements for the Round Table meeting at Tutulla Gutierrez. I hope to be able to attend, but perhaps because of the international situation it will be postponed.

I hope to start a minor excavation at El Baul next week.
