Studied in the Universities and museums of Helsinki, Berlin, Leipzig, Paris, Bruxelles, Rome, London, Oxford, and Chicago. -- Lecturer of Assyriology and Semitic Philology in the University of Helsinki 1939-49, acting professor of Oriental Literature in the Univ. of Helsinki 1940-45, research associate of the Oriental Institute of the Univ. of Chicago 1947-49, professor of Assyriology and Semitic Philology in the Univ. of Helsinki 1949-. -- Secretary general of the Finnish Oriental Society 1940-47, president 1949-. -- Publications: Über den syntaktischen Gebrauch der Flexionsendungen der Nomina im Uigurischen (1937), Zum Verständnis des sumerischen Schiffbautextes AO 5673 (1938), Die Wasserfahrzeuge in Babylonien (1939), Some Cuneiform Tablets from the Time of the third Ur Dynasty (1940, together with His Excellency Minister Harri Holma), Nautica Babyloniaca (1942), Über den Gebrauch der Hilfs- und deskriptiven Verba (1944), Der Abschnitt Wagen der 5.
